



## **TOOLS & SUPPLIES NEEDED**



#### **IMPORTANT**

#### **SAFETY TIPS:**

Be sure to read and understand all instructions before beginning installation.

Inspect all connections after installation.

Cover the drain to avoid loss of parts.

Be sure to wear proper eye protection.

Do NOT over tighten any connections or

Shut OFF water supplies before beginning installation


Observe all local plumbing and building codes

#### MAINTENANCE

Your new product is designed for years of trouble-free performance. Keep it looking new by cleaning it periodically with a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, steel wool, and harsh chemicals as these will dull the finish and void your warranty.

#### SITE PREPARATION

Ensure proper framing structure is present to support plumbing and product during use. Secure rough plumbing to framing structure. Rough plumbing must extend beyond the finished wall surface between 3/8" - 5/8". Provide a  $\varnothing 11/2"$  access hole in the finished wall surrounding each pipe exiting the wall. Cold Supply Line and Hot Supply Line MUST measure 8" from the center of one pipe to the center of the other pipe. Faucet inlet size is 1/2" NPT Female.




## PREPARE ECCENTRIC ADAPTERS

Ensure water supplies are turned OFF. Unthread Escutcheons and Spacers from Eccentric Adapters. Set aside for future use.




## **TEST FIT ECCENTRIC ADAPTERS**

The Eccentric Adapters allow for 1/16" of adjustment to correct misalignment of rough plumbing. Thread Eccentric Adapters onto 1/2" NPT rough plumbing exiting the finished wall surface. Hand tighten only.




## **ALIGNMENT OF ECCENTRIC ADAPTERS**

Slightly rotate the Eccentric Adapters left and right until the male threads of the Eccentric Adapters align with the Female Threads of the Mounting Nuts on the Faucet. Hand tighten Mounting Nuts to the Eccentric Adapters. Once properly aligned, wrench tighten the Eccentric Adapters to the rough plumbing, then remove Faucet from the Eccentric Adapters.



## **INSTALL FAUCET**


Align Spacers to Escutcheons. Thread Escutcheons onto Eccentric Adapters. Hand tighten firmly. Align Faucet to Eccentric Adapters. Thread Mounting Nuts onto Eccentric Adapters and wrench tighten connection.




## **FLUSH SYSTEM AND INSTALL AERATOR**
